Description

This is a survey course on England's history. It is offered as a *repertorio* of the Social Sciences area and is an optative course for History majors. Also, the course deals with the social, cultural and political movements of the nineteenth and twentieth centuries, the changes in Britain's role in world affairs and bring into discussion some of main issues of the present time.
